A RESOLUTION APPROVING THE REVISED SAN DIEGO POLICE DEPARTMENT AND SAN DIEGO FIRE-RESCUE DEPARTMENT SPECIAL EVENT PUBLIC SAFETY USER FEES AND AMENDING THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO RATEBOOK

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego [City] provides a number of public safety services to support special events and related activities throughout the City; and

WHEREAS, these events and activities range in scope from civic events such as festivals, parades, and runs sponsored by non-profit organizations to commercial public events, private corporate parties, collegiate and professional sport activities, concerts, exhibits and events in convention facilities and hotels, along with other activities such as filming; and

WHEREAS, the Office of Special Events conducted a full evaluation of the costs and revenues associated with providing City services, in accordance with the California Constitution as well as the State Government Code, which authorize local jurisdictions to impose fees, charges, and rates in order to recover costs associated with provided services; and

WHEREAS, it is the policy of the City to establish fees to recover the costs of providing services in accordance with the City of San Diego Administrative Regulation 95.25; and

WHEREAS, Administrative Regulation 95.25 encourages transferring specific fee schedules listed in the San Diego Municipal Code and Council Resolutions to the standardized Ratebook maintained by the City Clerk; and

WHEREAS, the City has an adopted User Fee Policy dated March 10, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the City has a cost recovery procedure for special event fees pursuant to San Diego Municipal Code section 22.4022; and

WHEREAS, the City has cost recovery agreements, in conjunction with San Diego
Municipal Code section 22.4022, with the San Diego Chargers, San Diego State Aztecs and San
Diego Padres; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Police Department and San Diego Fire-Rescue Department submitted full cost recovery fees related to special events to the Committee on Budget and Finance on April 1, 2009; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the fees related to special events, reflected in the summary and table, as REVISED ATTACHMENT A, are hereby approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is hereby directed to amend the City Ratebook to include the fees attached as REVISED ATTACHMENT A.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the fees, REVISED ATTACHMENT A, are to be effective beginning on July 1, 2009.


