A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER AND EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS AND AUTHORIZING THE FOURTH AMENDMENT TO AGREEMENT FOR THE BALBOA PARK ORNAMENTATION.

WHEREAS, on March 17, 2003, the Council authorized the City Manager, or designee, to secure \$6 million in State of California 2002 Resource Park Bond funds for the construction of cultural and historical projects in Balboa Park, to include the reconstruction of the West Arcade, construction of the Veterans Memorial Garden, and restoration of historic ornamentation on the Museum of Man/California Tower, the Museum of Art, and the Casa del Prado [Project]; and

WHEREAS, on September 27, 2004, by Resolution No. R-299686, the City Council authorized an Agreement with Heritage Architecture & Planning [Consultant] for Professional Architectural and Engineering Services for the Project in the amount of \$500,000; and

WHEREAS, on May 16, 2006, by Resolution No. R-301445, the City Council authorized the First Amendment to Agreement for the Consultant to provide additional Professional Architectural and Engineering Services in an amount not to exceed \$144,063.00; and

WHEREAS, on January 30, 2007, by Resolution No. R-302318, the City Council authorized the Second Amendment to Agreement for the Consultant to provide additional Professional Architectural and Engineering Services in an amount not to exceed \$37,560.00; and

WHEREAS, on September 2, 2008, by Resolution No. R- 304039, the City Council authorized the Third Amendment to Agreement for the Consultant to provide additional Professional and Architectural and Engineering Services in an amount not to exceed \$14,362.00; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to execute a Fourth Amendment to Agreement for the Consultant to provide additional Professional and Engineering Services for construction administration for a compensation amount not to exceed \$10,693.00, with a total compensation for services provided under the Agreement and subsequent amendments not to exceed \$706,678.00; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the transfer of funds in the amount of \$28,934.33 from CIP No. 22-963.0, Fanuel Street Park Walkway Reconstruction to CIP No. 21-855.0, Job Order No. 218554, Balboa Park Ornamentation/Cultural Projects (Casa del Prado) within Fund No. 630221, General Fund Contributions to the CIP is authorized.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Fourth Amendment to Agreement with Heritage Architecture and Planning for professional services for extended scope of work on CIP No. 21-855.0, Balboa Park Ornamentation/Cultural Projects (Museum of Man/California Tower, Museum of Art, Casa del Prado) in the amount of \$10,693.00, increasing the total amount to \$706,678.00, is authorized.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this activity is not a "project" and is therefore not subject o the California Environmental Quality Act [CEQA] per CEQA Guidelines section 15060(c)(3). The construction project for which this activity is associated is Categorically Exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act [CEQA] pursuant to State CEQA

Guidelines section 15331, Historical Resources Restoration/Rehabilitation (Project Number 96322, dated April 4, 2006).
