A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING A ONE-YEAR EXTENSION OF THE CROSSROADS REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT AREA COMMITTEE AND DIRECTING STAFF OF THE REDEVELOPMENT AGENCY OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO TO NOTICE AND CONDUCT THE ANNUAL PROJECT AREA COMMITTEE ELECTION IN 2009.

WHEREAS, on September 25, 2001, the Council of the City of San Diego [Council] adopted Resolution No. R-295512 thereby designating as a redevelopment survey area, pursuant to the California Community Redevelopment Law at Section 33310 of the California Health and Safety Code, the area known as the Crossroads Redevelopment Survey Area [Survey Area] for the purpose of determining whether a redevelopment project or projects within the Survey Area is feasible; and

WHEREAS, the California Community Redevelopment Law at Section 33385 of the California Health and Safety Code requires in certain situations that the Council call upon the residents, businesses and existing community organizations in a redevelopment project area to form a project area committee and to adopt, by Resolution, a procedure pursuant to Section 33385 for the formation of the project area committee, including the electoral process; and

WHEREAS, on April 2, 2002, the Council adopted Resolution No. R-296253 thereby calling upon the residents, businesses and existing community organizations to form a project area committee [Project Area Committee] for the proposed Crossroads Redevelopment Project Area [Project Area] and adopting the Procedure for Formation and Election of the Project Area Committee [Procedure]; and

WHEREAS, on July 8, 2002, the Council adopted Resolution No. R-296772 thereby confirming compliance with the Procedure in connection with the election conducted on May 15, 2002, and a subsequent run-off election conducted on May 29, 2002, for the Project Area Committee for the proposed Project Area; and

WHEREAS, on March 25, 2003, the Council adopted Resolution No. R-297791 thereby extending the Project Area Committee for the proposed Project Area until August 3, 2009; and

WHEREAS, on May 6, 2003, the Council adopted Ordinance No. O-19174 thereby approving and authorizing the Redevelopment Plan for the Crossroads Redevelopment Project Area [Crossroads Redevelopment Plan]; and

WHEREAS, the California Community Redevelopment Law at Section 33386 of the California Health and Safety Code provides that the Council may authorize additional one year extensions of a Project Area Committee; and

WHEREAS, the Project Area Committee for the Project Area is currently set to expire on August 3, 2009; and

WHEREAS, the Council determines that the continuation of consultations between the Redevelopment Agency of the City of San Diego [Agency] and the Project Area Committee is important to the successful implementation of the Crossroads Redevelopment Plan and the Project Area; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego [Council] as follows:

1. That the Council hereby authorizes the Project Area Committee [Project Area Committee] for the Crossroads Redevelopment Project Area [Project Area] to be extended for one additional year effective as of August 3, 2009.

- That the Council hereby directs the staff of the Redevelopment Agency of the
 City of San Diego [Agency] to notice and conduct the annual Project Area Committee election in
 2009.
- 3. That the Council finds and determines that this activity is not a "project" as defined by Section 15378 of the State California Environmental Quality Act [CEQA] Guidelines and is therefore not subject to CEQA pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15060(c)(3).
