WHEREAS, it is in the public interest for the civic leaders of San Diego to champion public works projects in their communities for addressing infrastructure needs and creating job opportunities; and


WHEREAS, the efficiency of the dedicated public works professionals is materially influenced by their skill set, work ethic and understanding of the importance of the work they perform; and


