A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING AN APPLICATION FOR A LOCAL GROUNDWATER ASSISTANCE GRANT FOR THE SAN PASQUAL BASIN GROUNDWATER MONITORING PROJECT.

WHEREAS, in October 2007, the State of California Department of Water Resources solicited projects for the Local Groundwater Assistance Program under the Proposition 50 Water Security, Clean Drinking Water, Coastal and Beach Protection Act of 2002 [Proposition 50] in order to provide grants to local public agencies to conduct groundwater studies, carry out groundwater monitoring, or groundwater management activities; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego Water Department's San Pasqual Basin Groundwater Monitoring Project is expected to assist in gaining knowledge of groundwater levels and water quality through installing a new monitoring well, reconditioning an existing well and collecting and analyzing the resulting data; and

WHEREAS, this activity is statutorily exempt from California Environmental Quality

Act [CEQA] pursuant to State CEQA Guidelines Section 15262; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego as follows:

- 1. That the Mayor or his designee is authorized and empowered on behalf of the City to prepare the necessary data to make an application to the California Department of Water Resources for a Local Groundwater Assistance Grant pursuant to Proposition 50 for grant funding for the San Pasqual Basin Groundwater Monitoring Project [Project].
- 2. That the Mayor or his designee is authorized and empowered to execute a grant funding agreement with the California Department of Water Resources to secure grant funds for the Project.

- 3. That the City Comptroller is authorized to accept, appropriate, and expend up to \$250,000 in grant funds for the Project contingent upon the City Comptroller first certifying that the funds are available and contingent upon the grant being secured.
- 4. That the City Comptroller is authorized, upon advice from the administering department, to transfer excess funds, if necessary, to the appropriate reserves.
