A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING APPLICATION FOR AND
ACCEPTANCE OF GRANT FUNDS FROM THE CALIFORNIA
INTEGRATED WASTE MANAGEMENT BOARD.

WHEREAS, the California Integrated Waste Management Board has established the
Local Enforcement Agency Grant Program to provide grant funding to Local Enforcement
Agencies to support the permitting and inspection of solid waste facilities; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego Solid Waste Local Enforcement Agency [LEA] was
certified in August 1999 by the California Integrated Waste Management Board to carry out the
duties and responsibilities of solid waste inspection, permitting and enforcement within the City
of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego Solid Waste LEA proposes to request grant funds,
each year for the next five years, for the purpose of purchasing computer equipment, software,
office and technical equipment, office supplies, public outreach materials and opportunities,
health and safety equipment, medical monitoring program, maintenance on existing equipment,
retaining consulting services, laboratory services, reference materials, professional memberships
and for additional training of LEA staff to carry out the duties and responsibilities of solid waste
inspection, permitting and enforcement; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego Solid Waste LEA is eligible for approximately
\$25,706.00 in grant funding (EA-20) from the California Integrated Waste Management Board
each year; and

WHEREAS, the California Integrated Waste Management Board requires the City Council to authorize certain matters by resolution prior to the funding of grant applications;

NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego as follows:

1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to submit applications to the California Integrated Waste Management Board for a Local Enforcement Agency Grant each year for the period of July 1, 2009 until June 30, 2014 and, if awarded, accept and expend grant funds.

2. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to conduct all negotiations, execute and submit all documents, including but not limited to applications, grant agreements, amendments, payment requests, which may be necessary to carry out and administer the obligations, responsibilities, and duties of the City of San Diego Solid Waste LEA under the terms of the grants.

3. That the City Comptroller is authorized to establish a separate fund for the grant monies and to deposit such grant monies as received.
