BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Attorney's Office is authorized to submit all documents, negotiate and execute all agreements necessary, including any amendments, to comply with the grant requirements, and carry out and administer all obligations, responsibilities and duties under the grant.

Criminal Division, for the one-year period of July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010, contingent

upon a fully executed grant agreement and City Comptroller certification of fund availability.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Comptroller is authorized to establish a

special interest-bearing fund for the grant money.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City of San Diego hereby agrees to hold the

State of California, its officers, agents and employees, harmless from any liability arising out of

the performance of the grant agreement, including court actions or damages, as detailed in the

Standard Agreement Number VCGC9074, and certifies that the City will not use the grant to

supplant local expenditures.
