WHEREAS, the State Agency and the City Attorney's Office have signed an agreement detailing the scope of work and terms and conditions of the grant; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the City Attorney's Office is hereby authorized to apply for and take all necessary actions to secure funding of a grant in an amount not to exceed \$75,194.00 from the State Victim Compensation and Government Claims Board to fund the Criminal Restitution Compact Restitution Specialist position in the City Attorney's Office, Criminal Division, for the one-year period of July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010, on the terms and conditions outlined in Standard Agreement Number VCGC9074, a copy of which is on file with the City Clerk's Office as Document No. RR

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BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Attorney's Office is authorized to submit all documents, negotiate and execute all agreements necessary, including any amendments, to comply with the grant requirements, and carry out and administer all obligations, responsibilities and duties under the grant.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that Financial Management is authorized to appropriate, and the City Comptroller is authorized to accept and expend, up to \$75,194.00 in grant funds from the State Victim Compensation and Government Claims Board, for the purpose of funding the Criminal Restitution Compact Restitution Specialist position in the City Attorney's Office, Criminal Division, for the one-year period of July 1, 2009 through June 30, 2010, contingent upon a fully executed grant agreement and City Comptroller certification of fund availability.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Comptroller is authorized to establish a special interest-bearing fund for the grant money.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City of San Diego hereby agrees to hold the State of California, its officers, agents and employees, harmless from any liability arising out of the performance of the grant agreement, including court actions or damages, as detailed in the Standard Agreement Number VCGC9074, and certifies that the City will not use the grant to supplant local expenditures.
