

RESOLUTION NUMBER R- 305011

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE ALLOCATION OF SETTLEMENT FUNDS IN THE CASE OF KEDAR PYATT AND MARY PYATT V. CITY OF SAN DIEGO, SAN DIEGO SUPERIOR COURT CASE NO. GIC 880621.

WHEREAS on May 17, 2005, the City Council [Council] of the City of San Diego
[City] authorized by Resolution No. 300434 the expenditure of funds up to \$650,000 for repair
and restoration of properties affected by a mudslide caused by a broken City storm drain pipe in
the La Jolla area of the City [Incident], including property owned by Kedar Pyatt and Mary
Pyatt; and

WHEREAS on July 24, 2006, by Resolution No. 301931, the Council authorized further funds, up to but not to exceed \$980,118.48, for completion of reconstruction and payment of damages to properties affected by the Incident; and

WHEREAS in June of 2007, Kedar and Mary Pyatt filed the case of *Kedar Pyatt and Mary Pyatt v. City of San Diego*, San Diego Superior Court Case No. GIC 880621 [Action] claiming inverse condemnation damages arising from the Incident; and

WHEREAS on October 14, 2008, the Council unanimously approved settlement of the Action in the amount of \$156,626.33 by a vote of 8 to 0;

NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the City of San Diego that the Council authorizes:

- 1. The sum of \$156,626.33 be paid from the Public Liability Fund (81140) in full and final settlement of the Action;
- 2. The Comptroller to issue one check in the amount of \$156,626.33 payable to Kedar and Mary Pyatt and their attorney of record, Darren Quinn, Esq. in final settlement of the Action;
 - The expenditure of \$156,626.33 from the Public Liability Fund No. 81140.
