A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING STORM DRAIN PROJECT FUNDING.

WHEREAS, the Storm Water Department has identified several projects in urgent need of action; and

WHEREAS, such action will require the transfer and expenditure of funds; and WHEREAS, this activity is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act pursuant to CEQA Guidelines section 15269(a) as emergency repairs to projects; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

- That the City Comptroller is authorized to transfer an amount not to exceed
   \$2,910,000 from General Fund, Storm Water Department, Fund No. 100, to Fund No. 630221,
   General Fund Contributions to CIP.
- 2. That in accordance with the annual appropriation ordinance, the City Comptroller is authorized to amend the Fiscal Year 2009 Capital Improvement Program budget by increasing CIP 13-005.0, Annual Allocation Drainage Projects, by an amount not to exceed \$2,910,000 provided that the Comptroller furnishes one or more certificates demonstrating that the funds are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.
- 3. That the City Comptroller is further authorized to appropriate and expend an amount not to exceed \$2,910,000 from Fund No. 630221, General Fund Contributions to the CIP, CIP 13-005.0, Annual Allocation Drainage Projects, provided that the Comptroller furnishes one or more certificates demonstrating that the funds are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

4. That the City Comptroller is further authorized to transfer excess budgeted funds, if any, to appropriate reserves on advice of the administering department.
