A RESOLUTION STATING FOR THE RECORD THAT PREVIOUSLY CERTIFIED EIR NO. 104495 HAS BEEN REVIEWED AND CONSIDERED AND NO SUBSTANTIAL CHANGES OR NEW INFORMATION WARRANTS ADDITIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL REVIEW FOR APPROVAL OF THE GENERAL PLAN ACTION PLAN.

WHEREAS, on March 10, 2008, the City Council adopted the General Plan by Resolution No. R-303473; and

WHEREAS, the City Council by Resolution No. R-303472, adopted on March 10, 2008, certified Environmental Impact Report No. 104495 prepared for the General Plan, a copy of which is on file in the Development Services Department; and

WHEREAS, the next step to implement the General Plan is for the City Council to adopt the General Plan Action Plan; and

WHEREAS, the Mitigation, Monitoring, and Reporting Program included within the final Environmental Impact Report No. 104495 addresses potential impacts that could result from implementation of the General Plan; and

WHEREAS, in connection with the consideration of the General Plan Action Plan, the implementation program for the General Plan, the City Council considered the issues discussed in Environmental Impact Report No. 104495; NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, stating for the record that the approval of the General Plan Action Plan is a subsequent discretionary approval of the

Project addressed in Environmental Impact Report No. 104495, and therefore not a separate project under CEQA Guideline sections 15060(c)(3) and 15378(c).

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, stating for the record that the information contained in the final Environmental Impact Report, including any comments received during the public review process, has been previously reviewed and considered by this Council and it is determined that this subsequent discretionary approval of the General Plan Action Plan does not involve change in circumstances, project changes, or new information of substantial importance which would warrant any additional environmental review.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is directed to file a Notice of Determination [NOD] with the Clerk of the Board of Supervisors for the County of San Diego regarding the above project.
