A RESOLUTION APPROVING PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS;
AUTHORIZING AWARD OF PUBLIC WORKS CONTRACT FOR
PIPELINE REHABILITATION PHASE J-1A AND TAKING
RELATED ACTIONS.

WHEREAS, the Pipeline Rehabilitation Phase J-1A is part of a program established by the City of San Diego and the Environmental Protection Agency mandating the rehabilitation of old and deteriorated sewer mains throughout the City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, this project includes the rehabilitation of 33,621 linear feet (6.37 miles) of sewer main which would occur in the City's right-of-way with trenchless technology; and

WHEREAS, the project would consist of the insertion of synthetic lining into the existing sewer mains via existing manholes and/or cleanouts, manhole replacement and related work; and

WHEREAS, this activity is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act [CEQA] pursuant to CEQA Guidelines sections 15301(b) as the repair and maintenance of an existing facility and 15302 as the replacement of reconstruction of existing structures and facilities; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the plans and specifications for the construction of Pipeline Rehabilitation Phase J-1A [Project], filed in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. ^{w.o.} 141721, are approved.

2. That, after advertising for bids in accordance with law, the Mayor or his designee is authorized to award a contract to, and execute a contract with, the lowest responsible and

reliable bidder for the Project [Contract], provided that the City Comptroller first furnishes one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure under the Contract are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

3. That the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$6,382,450 from CIP 46-050.0, Annual Allocation Pipeline Rehabilitation, Fund 41506, Sewer, is authorized solely and exclusively for the purpose of providing funds for the Project and related costs, provided that the City Comptroller first furnishes one or more certificates certifying that the funds are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

4. That the City Comptroller is authorized, upon advice from the administering department, to transfer excess budgeted funds, if any, to the appropriate reserves.
