RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE AND
RECORDATION OF AN EASEMENT DEED FOR
INSTALLATION OF A BACKFLOW VALVES FACILITY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to a permit granted by the United States of America, Department of the Navy [Navy], the City of San Diego [City] replaced an existing water meter and backflow valves, which were connected to the Nimitz Marine Facility, with a new valve series [New Water Facility] as part of Group Job 530; and


WHEREAS, the New Water Facility is raised above grade, in compliance with State regulations, along the east side of Rosecrans, just inside Navy property; and

WHEREAS, to formalize the installation of the New Water Facility, authorization is sought for the acceptance of an easement from Navy over the area in which the New Water Facility is located; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the Mayor or his designee, is hereby authorized to take all actions necessary to facilitate the acceptance and recordation of that certain easement deed which conveys to the City of San Diego those certain easement rights across that portion of the United States of America, Department of the Navy, Fort Rosecrans Military Reservation, located within Point Loma, in the County of San Diego, State of California, according to Miscellaneous Map

No. 129, filed in the office of the County Recorder of said San Diego County on April 16, 1934,
and as is more particularly described in the easement deed.
