A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING A \$149,686 INCREASE IN THE FISCAL YEAR 2010 CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS PROGRAM BUDGET IN CIP 52-766, UNIVERSITY AVENUE MOBILITY PROJECT; AND TO MAKE AVAILABLE \$179,000 FOR THE SAN YSIDRO HEALTH CENTER EXPANSION PROJECT.

WHEREAS, in 2005, the City received \$616,686 in Workforce Housing Reward Program funding from the State of California, Department of Housing & Community Development [DHCD] for four neighborhood improvement projects; and

WHEREAS, two of the projects, totaling \$288,000 were for improvements to Washington Street and Chollas Creek and are underway or completed; and

WHEREAS, the remaining two projects, in Greater North Park and San Ysidro were either not ready to occur or have been proven infeasible; and

WHEREAS, on February 10, 2009, DHCD approved revised scopes of work for the two projects; and

WHEREAS, this activity is exempt from the California Environmental Quality Act [CEQA] pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15061(b)(3); NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Comptroller is authorized to transfer an amount not to exceed \$149,686 from Fund 38336, Job Order No. 309091, 29th St. Plaza Improvements to CIP No. 39-207, North Park Commercial Revitalization Project.

2. That the Comptroller is authorized to transfer an amount not to exceed \$149,686

in TransNet funds from CIP No. 39-207, North Park Commercial Revitalization Project, to CIP

No. 52-766, University Avenue Mobility Project.

3. That the Fiscal Year 2010 Capital Improvements Program Budget for CIP No.

52-766 University Avenue Mobility Project is amended by increasing the budget amount by

\$149,686.

4. That the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$149,686 from CIP No. 52-766,

University Avenue Mobility Project, is authorized, solely and exclusively for the purpose of

providing funds for removal of concrete sidewalk and replacement with exposed aggregate

sidewalk and installation of pedestrian ramps, provided that the Comptroller first furnishes one

or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit

with the City Treasurer.

5. That the Comptroller is authorized to make available an amount not to exceed

\$179,000 from Fund 38336, Job Order No. 309093, Mi Pueblo Pilot Village Traffic Calming

Infrastructure Project to the San Ysidro Health Center Expansion Project for improvements to

Beyer Boulevard in the San Ysidro Community.

6. That the Comptroller, upon advice from the administering department, is


authorized to transfer excess budgeted funds, if any, to the appropriate reserves.

The purpose of this memo is to request your signature of Revised Copy 1 of City Council Resolution #R-305084. On July 22, 2009 the City Council adopted Resolution#R-305084 which authorized the expenditure of \$149,686 in grant funds to the 29th Street Pedestrian Plaza Improvement Project in North Park and the transfer of an additional \$149,686 to implement the University Avenue Mobility Project – comprehensive pedestrian and bicycle safety improvements along University Avenue in North Park.

Recently it was brought to my attention that the \$149,686 to be transferred to the University Avenue Mobility Project has not yet been transferred.
