A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$282,000 TO FUND THE TRANSITIONAL HOUSING PROGRAM FOR HOMELESS SENIORS.

WHEREAS, the Transitional Housing for Seniors Program [Program] is sponsored by the City of San Diego to provide homeless seniors with vouchers to rent rooms at housing facilities downtown and in surrounding neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency has provided funding support to the Program since 2002 with expenditures from the Centre City or Horton Plaza Low- and Moderate- Income Housing Fund No. 98446; and

WHEREAS, the Senior Community Centers is expected to operate the Program on behalf of the City this year; and

WHEREAS, the City is requesting \$282,000 to fund leasing costs for 37 rooms and program administration for the 12-month period of July 2009 to June 2010; NOW,

THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the City Council authorizes the acceptance, appropriation, and expenditure of funds in the amount of \$282,000 from the Redevelopment Agency's FY 2010 Horton Plaza Low- and Moderate- Income Housing Fund No. 98446.

2. That the City Council authorizes the Mayor or his designee to negotiate and execute an agreement with Senior Community Centers to expend an amount not to exceed \$282,000 from the FY 2010 Horton Plaza Low- and Moderate- Income Housing Fund for the

operation of the Program, contingent upon certification of funds availability by the City Auditor and Comptroller.


