A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO ACCEPTING AND APPROPRIATING FUNDS IN THE AMOUNT OF \$282,000 TO FUND THE TRANSITIONAL HOUSING PROGRAM FOR HOMELESS SENIORS.

WHEREAS, the Transitional Housing for Seniors Program [Program] is sponsored by the City of San Diego to provide homeless seniors with vouchers to rent rooms at housing facilities downtown and in surrounding neighborhoods; and

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency has provided funding support to the Program since 2002 with expenditures from the Centre City or Horton Plaza Low- and Moderate- Income Housing Fund No. 98446; and

WHEREAS, the Senior Community Centers is expected to operate the Program on behalf of the City this year; and

WHEREAS, the City is requesting \$282,000 to fund leasing costs for 37 rooms and program administration for the 12-month period of July 2009 to June 2010; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the City Council authorizes the acceptance, appropriation, and expenditure of funds in the amount of \$282,000 from the Redevelopment Agency's FY 2010 Horton Plaza Low- and Moderate- Income Housing Fund No. 98446.
- 2. That the City Council authorizes the Mayor or his designee to negotiate and execute an agreement with Senior Community Centers to expend an amount not to exceed \$282,000 from the FY 2010 Horton Plaza Low- and Moderate- Income Housing Fund for the

operation of the Program, contingent upon certificati	ion of funds availability by the City Auditor
and Comptroller.	•
