A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING AN AGREEMENT WITH ESTRADA LAND PLANNING FOR AS-NEEDED PROFESSIONAL LANDSCAPE ARCHITECTURAL DESIGN SERVICES; AND AUTHORIZING RELATED EXPENDITURES.

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego [City] is in need of landscape architectural design services on an as-needed basis; and

WHEREAS, the City issued a Request for Proposal for as-needed landscape architectural design services and after interviews Estrada Land Planning was selected as the best qualified to provide such services to the City; and

WHEREAS, this activity is not subject to the California Environmental Quality Act [CEQA] pursuant to CEQA Guidelines Section 15060(c)(3), because it is not a project as defined by Section 15378; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to execute, for and on behalf of the City, an Agreement with Estrada Land Planning for as-needed landscape architectural design services to the City in a total amount not to exceed \$3,000,000 and under the terms and conditions set forth in the Agreement, on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR 305111

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that prior to the award of each task order under the Agreement, the City Comptroller must first provide one or more certificates demonstrating that the necessary funds are, or will be, on deposit in the City Treasury.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$1,000 from CIP No. 29-970.0, 252 Corridor Park South (Phase II), Fund No. 10267, SC-RDA Contribution to CIP, is authorized, solely and exclusively to provide funds for the minimum guaranteed task order under the above Agreement.
