A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE CITY COMPTROLLER TO TRANSFER AN ESTIMATED \$1.58 MILLION BUT NOT TO EXCEED \$3.00 MILLION FROM THE GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATED RESERVE (602) TO FIRE-RESCUE DEPARTMENT (120).

WHEREAS, the Fire-Rescue Department year-end expenditures exceed budgetary authority previously granted by City Council necessitating this urgent action to correct the expenditure appropriation to close Fiscal Year 2009 within budget; and

WHEREAS, the year-end amendment to the Appropriation Ordinance, O-19869, granted authority to increase the Fire-Rescue Department budget by \$4.25 million; and

WHEREAS, this was primarily due to an increase in overtime related to Strike Team activities for the wildfires and other Federal Emergency Management Agency requirements, as a result, the Fire-Rescue Department appropriations were increased to \$192.66 million; and

WHEREAS, the Fire-Rescue Department is estimated to end the year with \$5.43 million, or 2.8 percent, of expenditures over the revised budget of \$192.66 million, this is due to an estimated \$3.01 million of termination pay expenses incurred in June 2009 due to unanticipated retirements and an increase in reimbursable Emergency Medical Services; and

WHEREAS, section 2.b.k of the amendment to the Appropriation Ordinance (O-19869) provides authorization to increase appropriations by an amount not to exceed 2.0 percent of each department's budget and this allows for an increase of \$3.85 million to \$196.52 million. The remaining estimated variance is \$1.58 million, or 0.8 percent of the \$196.52 million budget; and

WHEREAS, per the Fiscal Year 2009 Appropriation Ordinance, O-19774, Section 2.I.D, the City Comptroller is authorized to transfer appropriations from the General Fund Appropriated Reserve to other General Fund departments upon adopted Council resolution; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, the City Council authorizes the City Comptroller to transfer an estimated \$1.58 million but not to exceed \$3.00 million from the General Fund Appropriated Reserve (602) to Fire-Rescue Department (120).
