A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE SAN DIEGO POLICE DEPARTMENT TO PARTICIPATE WITH THE CALIFORNIA HIGHWAY PATROL IN THE 'DRIVING UNDER THE INFLUENCE COLLEGE CORRIDOR PROJECT' AND TO BE REIMBURSED UP TO \$12,500 IN GRANT FUNDS.

WHEREAS, the California Highway Patrol [CHP] has received a grant from the Office of Traffic Safety for the 'Driving Under the Influence [DUI] College Corridor Project;' and

WHEREAS, the grant is intended to reduce the number of alcohol-related collisions, fatalities, and injuries by targeting DUI enforcement in the vicinity of the University of California, San Diego campus; and

WHEREAS, within the City of San Diego, the program will target DUI enforcement along the program's designated corridor of Interstate 5, Interstate 805, and Interstate 8; and

WHEREAS, CHP has approximately \$12,500 in grant funds available for the San Diego Police Department [SDPD] to participate in joint DUI enforcement activities; and

WHEREAS, SDPD wishes to enter into an agreement with CHP documenting this partnership and creating a method for SDPD to be reimbursed by CHP grant funds for overtime incurred during these operations; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor or his designee, be and is hereby authorized and empowered, for and on behalf of the City, to apply for and take all necessary action to secure funding in the amount of \$12,500 from the CHP for the 'Driving Under the Influence College Corridor Project.'

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to accept up to \$12,500 in grant funds or the actual amount of funding authorized by the CHP, if the grant funding is secured.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to establish a special interest-bearing fund for the grant funds, if required.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate and expend up to \$12,500 in grant funds, or the actual amount of funding authorized by CHP, for the purpose of implementing the "College Corridor" grant program, contingent upon receipt of a fully-executed grant agreement.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief of Police is authorized to administer and operate this program, including any amendments, extensions, augmentations, or renewals from the CHP for identical or closely related purposes; and to certify that the City will comply with all applicable statutory and regulatory requirements.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this authorization shall be valid for a period of up to five years, provided funding for this purpose is made available by the CHP.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any resources received hereunder shall be used to supplement and not to supplant expenditures controlled by this body.


