BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, in appreciation of the Torrey Pines Association's tremendous accomplishments and continuing dedication to protecting and preserving the natural

beauty of Torrey Pines State Natural Reserve, does hereby declare September 15, 2009, to be "TORREY PINES ASSOCIATION DAY" in the City of San Diego.
