A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING EXECUTION OF THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH GEOLOGIC ASSOCIATES FOR AS-NEEDED LANDFILL ENVIRONMENTAL REGULATORY COMPLIANCE SERVICES; AND AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS FOR THE FIRST AMENDMENT.

WHEREAS, to maintain compliance with state landfill regulations, the Council in November 2005 authorized an agreement with GeoLogic Associates to provide professional environmental regulatory compliance services at various City landfills; and

WHEREAS, to remain in compliance with state regulations, the City wishes to continue using the services of GeoLogic on an as-needed basis at the West Miramar Landfill and various inactive City landfills; and

WHEREAS, the Natural Resources & Culture Committee heard this item on July 22, 2009 and voted to forward it to the full Council without recommendation; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Mayor or his designee is authorized to execute, for and on behalf of the City, an amendment to the agreement with GeoLogic Associates, under the terms and conditions set forth in the First Amendment, on file with the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 305254.

2. That the Chief Financial Officer as delegated to the City Comptroller is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$250,000 from Fund No. 700039, Refuse Disposal Enterprise, solely and exclusively to provide funds for the above First Amendment.
