DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE OCT 1 2009

WHEREAS, in 1985, the California Coastal Cleanup Day was established to remove litter and prevent marine debris from taking a toll on underwater environments; and

WHEREAS, during the 25-year history of California Coastal Cleanup Day, over one million people have volunteered across the State of California to clean up our beaches and protect vital species including local Shrikes, the California Least Tern, and the Green Sea Turtle; and


WHEREAS, this year, an estimated 350,000 volunteers will gather to clean the coastlines and inland areas at approximately 750 clean-up sites in California, including 78 in San Diego County; and

WHEREAS, the annual California Coastal Cleanup Day provides an opportunity for San Diego residents to express their civic pride and community unity, while offering an opportunity for future generations to learn about sustainable practices and environmental stewardship; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, does hereby proclaim September 19, 2009, to be the **“25TH ANNUAL CALIFORNIA COASTAL CLEANUP DAY”** in recognition of the

volunteers, businesses, government agencies, environmental groups and others that contribute to the region's prosperity and quality of life by protecting and preserving San Diego's Coastline.


