A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, AND EXPEND \$348,774 IN GRANT FUNDS PURSUANT TO THE INTERNET CRIMES AGAINST CHILDREN TASK FORCE GRANT PROGRAM, UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, FY 2009 CONTINUATION PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the federal government has continued to make grant funding available to law enforcement through the United States Department of Justice for the 2009 Internet Crimes Against Children [ICAC] Task Force Program Continuation Grant Program [Program]; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego [City] has participated in the Program since 2000 (Resolution R-293034); and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to apply for, accept, expend such grant funds for law enforcement purposes, specifically in support of the San Diego Internet Crimes Against Children [SDICAC] Task Force; and

WHEREAS, the grant funds will be used for personnel; travel; equipment and supplies including technological support; and partial salaries for three other law enforcement personnel from other agencies who are dedicated to the SDICAC Task Force; and

WHEREAS, the City wishes to apply for, accept, and expend \$348,774 in grant funds;  
NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to take all necessary action to secure funding, to apply for, accept, and

expend grant funding up to \$348,774 from the U.S. Department of Justice ICAC Grant Program, as part of the FY 2009 Continuation Grant Program.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to establish a special interest-bearing fund for such funds, if required.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to accept, appropriate and expend up to \$348,774 to implement the 2009 ICAC Program Continuation Grant Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor or his designee is authorized to administer and operate this program for a period of up to five years, provided that funding for this purpose is made available by the U.S. Department of Justice.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that any resources received hereunder shall be used to supplement and not to supplant expenditures controlled by this body; and that grant-funded positions are not subject to local hiring freezes.
