WHEREAS, the Senior Affairs Advisory Board [Board] is established in San Diego Municipal Code section 26.1501 and, under the Mayor-Council form of governance, is advisory to the Mayor, and through the Mayor to the City Council, on the matters which directly impact the elderly; and

WHEREAS, the Board advises on policy and issues relating to transportation, security at home, improved intergenerational interaction, meal delivery, housing, improved City-County cooperation, and other issues as determined by the Chair; and

WHEREAS, the Board makes recommendations for improving communications between seniors and City government; review City employment policies for seniors; perform studies and surveys as requested by the Mayor and Council; advise on relevant issues and formation of laws, policies, or procedures which may affect seniors; and report annually to the Mayor and Council on the "State of the Seniors" within the City of San Diego; and

WHEREAS, San Diego Municipal Code section 26.1502 provides that the Board shall consist of eleven members who serve two-year terms and serve until their successors are appointed and qualified; and

WHEREAS, the expiration date of all terms shall be May 31 and not more than six terms shall expire in any year; and

WHEREAS, seven terms are scheduled to expire in 2010, including that of Paul Downey, who has resigned; and

WHEREAS, in order to comply with San Diego Municipal Code section 26.1502, the expiration date for the seat formerly held by Mr. Downey is extended to May 31, 2011, instead of May 31, 2010; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the following appointment by the Mayor of the City of San Diego to the Senior Affairs Advisory Board, for a term expiring as indicated, and in the category indicated, be and the same is hereby confirmed:
