committed their efforts to supply needed goods to wounded veterans at Balboa Naval Hospital;
and

WHEREAS, Queen Creek's award-winning Park and Recreation senior program group
known as "Stitching Hands" is a valuable asset and partner of Operation Wounded Warrior by
hand-crafting pajamas, lap quilts, gloves, slippers and many other items for the returning service
members; and


WHEREAS, more than one thousand items have been delivered to Balboa Naval Hospital
through Operation Wounded Warrior; and

WHEREAS, in 2009, the riders of Operation Wounded Warrior will deliver
approximately 500 handmade items from "Stitching Hands" and more than \$100,000 in health
and comfort items collected from Arizona, Nevada, California, New Mexico, and Texas to the
wounded service men and women now at Camp Pendleton Hospital, Balboa Naval Hospital, and
Brooks Army Medical Center in Texas; NOW, THEREFORE,
