WHEREAS, it is imperative that every elected representative seek sensible reforms that will discourage the filing of frivolous lawsuits, reduce litigation costs, and protect victims from outrageous contingency fees; and

WHEREAS, the jury process works to safeguard the justice system by holding the government to the principles of its constitution; and

WHEREAS, the dedicated work of the Citizens Against Lawsuit Abuse [CALA] plays an integral role in restoring fairness and balance to the civil justice system by encouraging citizens to serve on a jury when called; and

WHEREAS, CALA's mission is to educate the public about the human and financial costs of lawsuit abuse and therefore create a climate for change; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, does hereby proclaim the week of October 5, 2009, as "LAWSUIT ABUSE AWARENESS WEEK" in the City of San Diego.
