WHEREAS, San Ysidro Adult School has contributed to the civic participation of its students through its English Language Civics curriculum; and

WHEREAS, San Ysidro Adult School has served as a center for community activity, offering free Parenting and Health and Safety classes; and

WHEREAS, San Ysidro Adult School has helped raise the literacy and education level of its adult community, enabling its students to prepare for greater upward mobility in both the workplace and in higher education, thereby helping to positively influence the children of that same community in a multitude of ways; and

WHEREAS, San Ysidro Adult School has augmented its students' educational experiences with a variety of life-enriching skills and opportunities for its diverse population; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that this Council, for and on behalf of the people of San Diego, does hereby proclaim October 19, 2009, to be "SAN YSIDRO ADULT SCHOOL DAY" in celebration of Adult Education and Family Literacy Week, October 18 to 23, 2009.
