WHEREAS, the California Association for Nurse Practitioners (CANP) consists of 2,550 members representing over 14,000 California Nurse Practitioners in a statewide network of over 21 regions; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of CANP is to promote a strong nurse practitioner movement through a statewide communication system and to strengthen the public image of the nurse practitioner; and

WHEREAS, by providing desperately needed health care in many urban and central city communities, Nurse Practitioners improve the health care system's ability to reach underserved populations; and



hereby declare November 8 to 15, 2009, to be "NURSE PRACTITIONERS WEEK" in the City of San Diego.


