A RESOLUTION ADOPTING THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO'S
LABOR COMPLIANCE PROGRAM IN CONFORMANCE
WITH THE REQUIREMENTS OF THE STATE OF
CALIFORNIA DEPARTMENT OF INDUSTRIAL RELATIONS.

WHEREAS, in August 2003, the City of San Diego's application for certification as a Labor Compliance Program was approved by the State of California's Department of Industrial Relations [DIR]; and

WHEREAS, the City thereafter, through its Equal Opportunity Contracting [EOC] Department, administered a Labor Compliance Program, which has since expired; and

WHEREAS, California Labor Code section 1771.5 permits a local agency to administer its own Labor Compliance Program to ensure that state and federal laws regarding Prevailing Wages and other labor regulations are properly enforced; and

WHEREAS, the City is in the process of renewing its application with DIR for certification as a Labor Compliance Program, and DIR requires City Council approval of the proposed program; and


WHEREAS a certified Labor Compliance Program is required for the receipt of funds through the Water Security, Clean Drinking Water, Coastal and Beach Protection Act of 2002;

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:


