A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO MAKE APPLICATION TO THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA TO THE CALIFORNIA ARTS COUNCIL STATE LOCAL PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the State legislation established and funded the State Local Partnership

Program [SLPP] under the California Arts Council [CAC] to foster cultural development on the
local level through a partnership between the CAC and SLPP; and

WHEREAS, the nature of this partnership includes funding, information exchange, cooperative activities, and leadership to enable individuals, organizations and communities to create, present and preserve the art of all cultures to enrich the quality of life for all Californians; and

WHEREAS, the goals of the SLPP are to increase public awareness of, and participation in the arts of all cultures; to advocate for the arts at all levels; to encourage and promote arts in education; to encourage local communities to foster the growth of arts resources to meet local needs; to encourage local and regional partnership development promoting the health of the arts; to provide access to high quality artistic experiences for all Californians and to promote cooperation and collaboration in planning, programming and policy development; and

WHEREAS, the CAC projects that \$15,000 will be granted to the City in FY10 subject to the availability of funds in the State budget and on condition that the City provides a one-to-one funding match; and

WHEREAS, the Commission's FY10 administrative budget will provide the matching funds; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that it authorize the Mayor or his designee to make application to the State of California to the California Arts Council and State Local Partnership Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, authorize the Mayor or his designee to take all necessary actions to secure funding from the CAC to develop effective public art policy, advocacy, strategic partnerships, and technical services, pending receipt of a fully executed grant agreement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, authorize the Comptroller to establish a fund for the grant.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, authorize the Comptroller to accept, appropriate and expend the grant, pending receipt of a fully executed grant agreement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, allocate matching funds of \$15,000 from the Commission's FY10 Miscellaneous Contractual Services Budget.
