AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE FIRST AMENDMENT TO
AN AGREEMENT WITH RJC ARCHITECTS, INC. FOR THE
LA JOLLA CHILDREN'S POOL LIFEGUARD STATION.

WHEREAS, the existing facility is old, undersized, deteriorated and no longer serves the needs of the lifeguard staff; and

WHEREAS, in February 2008 the existing facility was condemned and since then lifeguard staff have been using a temporary facility; and

WHEREAS, on July 28, 2009, the updated list of deferred maintenance projects was approved by City Council and the list included funds for design completion of the La Jolla Children's Pool Lifeguard Station; and

WHEREAS, RJC Architects, Inc. was selected in accordance with Council Policy 300-7, and entered into an agreement with the City of San Diego on May, 31, 2001, as Document No. C-10757; and

WHEREAS, the proposed First Amendment to the Agreement with RJC Architects, Inc. is required to complete the site and coastal development permits and prepare the bridging documents that the design-build teams will base their proposals on, and to provide support during the design-build phase; and

WHEREAS, under Charter Section 99, no contract, agreement or obligation extending for a period of more than five years may be authorized except by Ordinance approved by a two-thirds majority vote of the City Council; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 1. That the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to execute, for and on behalf of said City, a First Amendment to an Agreement with RJC Architects, Inc, for the purpose of completing the bridging documents for the La Jolla Children's Pool Lifeguard Station [Project] under the terms and conditions set forth in the First Amendment to the Agreement, on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. OO 19987.

Section 2. That the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$71,250 from CIP No. S-00644, La Jolla Children's Pool Lifeguard Station, is authorized for the purpose of executing this First Amendment to the Agreement, contingent upon the City Comptroller first certifying funds are available providing funds for the above referenced Project.

Section 3. That the Chief Financial Officer, upon advice from the administering department, is authorized to transfer excess funds, if any, to the appropriate reserves.

Section 4. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its passage, a written or printed copy having been available to the City Council and the public a day prior to its passage.

Section 5. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.
