WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Relations Department is charged with developing the City's draft annual legislative program for approval by the City Council; and

WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Relations Department has provided the City Council with a proposed legislative program with a proactive list of legislative, budgetary or regulatory priorities for the upcoming year in both Sacramento and Washington, D.C.; NOW,

THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Proposed 2010 Legislative Program, as set forth in the January 25, 2010 Report to the City Council, Report No. 10-012, a copy of which is on file in the Office of the City Clerk as Document No.

RR- 305612, is hereby approved with the following modifications: (1) add support for increasing the amount of State Revolving Funds and specifically for Indirect Potable Reuse; (2) seek funding for Regional Parks including Balboa Park, San Diego River Valley, Mission Trails, Tijuana River Valley, San Dieguito River Valley, and coastal parks; and (3) identify and monitor legislative actions to aid pension reform including but not limited to IRS regulations and requirements related to a tiered opt-out plan, and that staff provide a report on any work in this area before Council takes further action.


