A RESOLUTION OF THE SAN DIEGO CITY COUNCIL
AMENDING COUNCIL POLICY 900-14 AND CONTINUING
THE MINISTERIAL PROCESS REGARDING PRIVATE
DEVELOPMENT PROJECTS, PERTAINING TO THE CITY'S
SUSTAINABLE BUILDING POLICY.

WHEREAS, in order to reconcile City policy with state law and policies regarding renewable energy and energy efficiency in City owned and leased facilities, Council Policy 900-14 requires updating; and

WHEREAS, since April 2008, City staff and the Sustainable Energy Advisory Board have worked to draft an updated policy; and

WHEREAS, on March 3, 2010, the Land Use & Housing Committee approved the proposed revised Council Policy 900-14; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that existing Council Policy No. 900-14 titled "Sustainable Building Policy" is hereby dissolved in its entirety and replaced by a revised Council Policy 900-14, as set forth in the document filed in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 305832.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the provisions of former Council Policy 900-14 at page 4 relating to the expedition of the ministerial process for approval of private development projects shall continue to be applicable to such projects and shall be maintained by the Development Services Department until such time as those provisions are incorporated into amendments to Council Policy 600-27.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Clerk is instructed to add the aforesaid revised Council Policy 900-14 to the Council Policy Manual.
