A RESOLUTION OF THE SAN DIEGO CITY COUNCIL
ACCEPTING A GRANT AND TAKING RELATED ACTIONS IN
CONNECTION WITH THE HEALTHY HOMES PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the City previously received grant funding from the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development under its Healthy Homes Demonstration Grant Program and is eligible to receive further grant funding; and

WHEREAS, subject to Council approval, the grant funding would be used for the City's healthy homes program; and

WHEREAS, the Land Use & Housing Committee approved this item on April 21, 2010;
NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor or his designee is authorized, for and on behalf of the City, to accept grant funding from the U.S. Housing and Urban Development Department (HUD) in the amount of \$874,667 under the Healthy Homes Demonstration Grant Program (Grant), to be used for improving the identification and control of multiple residential health and safety hazards, and to negotiate, execute, and comply with the agreement with HUD for the Grant.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate and expend an amount not to exceed \$874,667 from Fund No. 600000, Grant Fund – Federal, Cost Center 21151112, solely and exclusively to provide funds for improving the identification and control of multiple residential health and safety hazards, contingent on receipt of a fully executed Grant agreement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor or his designee is authorized to take all necessary action to administer, monitor, and manage the Grant agreement with HUD and, when required, to develop, advertise, negotiate, and award contracts to third parties in order to implement the Grant agreement.
