A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR, CHIEF OPERATING OFFICER, CHIEF FINANCIAL OFFICER, FIRE CHIEF, OR THE OFFICE OF HOMELAND SECURITY PROGRAM MANAGER TO ACCEPT, APPROPRIATE, AND EXPEND UP TO \$776,100 IN GRANT FUNDS FOR PERSONNEL EXPENSES AND ACCEPT \$1.3 MILLION IN PREVENTIVE RADIOLOGICAL/NUCLEAR DETECTION EQUIPMENT FROM THE FISCAL YEAR 2010 DOMESTIC NUCLEAR DETECTION OFFICE – WEST COAST MARITIME PILOT GRANT PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the U.S. Department of Homeland Security established the West Coast Maritime Pilot [WCMP] Program that is managed by the Domestic Nuclear Detection Office [DNDO] to develop and assess preventive radiological/nuclear detection capabilities for State and local authorities; and

WHEREAS, the WCMP Program addresses the risk of illicit radiological/nuclear materials or weapons entering our nation's waterways on small maritime vessels due to the unique maritime environment, volume and freedom of vessel movement, and 95,000 miles of shoreline to protect; and

WHEREAS, the goal of the WCMP Program is to prevent the exploitation of small maritime vessels to conduct a direct-to-target attack of population centers or infrastructure near the water, or the use of intermodal transportation to attack a target farther inland; and

WHEREAS, San Diego, California, has been selected as a pilot port under the WCMP Program for its commercial and military importance, critical infrastructure, proximity to an international border, highly concentrated population adjacent to shore, and the existence of a Joint Harbor Operations Center; and

WHEREAS, the FY 2010 WCMP Grant Program will provide grant funds to assist the San Diego Urban Area [SDUA] maritime region to evaluate and implement preventive radiological/nuclear detection operational capabilities in the maritime community, and to participate in training, planning, and support activities; and

WHEREAS, the San Diego Urban Area maritime region includes the San Diego Police Department, San Diego Fire-Rescue Department, San Diego Lifeguard Service, Port of San Diego Harbor Police, County of San Diego Department of Environmental Health, California Department of Fish and Games, U.S. Customs and Border Protection, and U.S. Coast Guard; and

WHEREAS, the FY 2010 WCMP Grant Program will provide an amount not to exceed \$776,100 for personnel expenses related to exercise and training for the WCMP Program; and

WHEREAS, the SDUA is eligible for reimbursement for exercise and training expenses incurred in relation to the WCMP Program since July 1, 2009, with grant funds to be provided for future expenses for one year from the date of the award; and

WHEREAS, the FY 2010 WCMP Grant Program will provide the SDUA with preventive radiological/nuclear detection equipment worth approximately \$1.3 million to support operational capabilities; and

WHEREAS, the sustainment costs for this equipment are eligible for funding under the Homeland Security Grant Program; NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor, Chief Operating Officer, Chief Financial Officer, Fire Chief, or the Office of Homeland Security Program Manager is authorized, for and on behalf of the City, to accept, appropriate, and expend an amount not to exceed \$776,100 in grant funds for personnel expenses related to exercise and

training for the WCMP Program as the City's authorized agent under the FY 2010 WCMP Grant Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, Chief Operating Officer, Chief Financial Officer, Fire Chief, or the Office of Homeland Security Program Manager is authorized, for and on behalf of the City, to accept up to \$1.3 million in preventive radiological/nuclear detection equipment for the SDUA under the FY 2010 WCMP Grant Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, Chief Operating Officer, Chief Financial Officer, Fire Chief, or the Office of Homeland Security Program Manager is authorized to execute all agreements necessary to comply with the FY 2010 WCMP Grant Program.
