A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING
AN ADDITIONAL EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS FOR THE SAN
DIEGO RIVER MULTI-USE PATH PROJECT.

WHEREAS, the construction of the San Diego River Multi-Use Path will provide pedestrians and bicyclists access between the Fashion Valley Shopping Center and the west end of Hazard Center Drive; and

WHEREAS, the multi-use pathway will be located within the San Diego River Park on the north side of the San Diego River and south of the Hazard Center Drive Extension Project; and

WHEREAS, this project is consistent with and is part of the draft San Diego River Park Master Plan and the Mission Valley Community Plan; and

WHEREAS, additional funds are necessary to address concerns related to the project's environmental permitting and to coordinate design changes which were necessary to address the adjacent Hazard Center Drive Extension and State Road 163/Friars Road Interchange Projects;
NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the City Comptroller is authorized to transfer an amount not to exceed \$100,000 within Fund 400156, TransNet, from CIP S-00660, Public Roads Supporting Park Access, to CIP S-00958, San Diego River Multi-Use Path [Project].
2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$100,000 from S-00958, San Diego River Multi-Use Path, Fund 400156, TransNet, for the

purpose of providing funds for the Project, provided that the City Comptroller first furnishes one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

3. That the City Comptroller, upon advice from the administering department, is authorized to transfer excess budgeted funds, if any, to the appropriate reserves.
