A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL APPROVING THE PLANS AND SPECIFICATIONS, AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS AND RELATED ACTIONS FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF PIPELINE REHABILITATION PHASE K-1 PROJECT.

WHEREAS, Pipeline Rehabilitation Phase K-1 Project [Project] is part of the City of San Diego's Sewer Main Replacement Program as mandated by the Environmental Protection Agency; and

WHEREAS, this Project is located in the Linda Vista and Serra Mesa communities, and includes the rehabilitation of approximately 36,465 linear feet of 8-inch sewer mains with trenchless technology, the repair or rehabilitation of 25 existing manholes, and the construction of 31 new manholes and all other work and appurtenances; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego [Council] that the plans and specifications for the construction of the Project, as advertised by the Purchasing and Contracting w.3.5.

Department, filed in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. 3-10141, are approved.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that after advertising for bids in accordance with law, the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to execute a construction contract with the lowest responsible and reliable bidder, provided that the City Comptroller first furnishes one or more certificates certifying that funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer [CFO], as delegated to Financial Management is authorized to appropriate, and the City Comptroller is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$4,928,352.50 from Sewer Fund 700000, CIP A-JA.00002 (Legacy CIP 46-050.0), Annual Allocation – Pipeline Rehabilitation for the construction and related costs of the Project, contingent upon the City Comptroller first furnishing one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the City Comptroller is authorized, upon advice from the administering department, to transfer excess budgeted funds, if any, to the appropriate reserves.
