A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING APPLICATION FOR AND EXPENDITURE OF STATE GRANT FUNDS FOR THE CALIFORNIA ARTS COUNCIL STATE LOCAL PARTNERSHIP PROGRAM.

WHEREAS, the State of California legislation established and funded the State Local Partnership Program [SLPP] under the California Arts Council [CAC] to foster cultural development on the local level through partnership between the CAC and the state's local arts agencies; and

WHEREAS, the nature of this partnership includes funding, information exchange, cooperative activities and leadership to enable individuals, organizations and communities to enrich the quality of life for all Californians; and

WHEREAS, CAC projects that \$15,000 will be granted to the City FY 2011 subject to the availability of funds in the State budget and on condition that the City provides a one-to-one funding match; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

- 1. That the Mayor, or his representative, is authorized and empowered for and on behalf of the City to make an application to the State of California for the California Arts Council State Local Partnership Program [Project].
- 2. That the Mayor, or his representative, is authorized and empowered to take all necessary actions to secure funds from the CAC to develop effective public art policy, advocacy,

strategic partnerships and technical services, pending receipt of a fully executed grant agreement for the Project.

- 3 That the City Comptroller is authorized to established a fund for the grant.
- 4. That the City Comptroller is authorized to accept, appropriate and expend grant funds, pending receipt of a fully executed grant agreement.
- 5. Allocate matching funds of \$15,000 from the Commission's FY11 operating budget, contingent upon approval of the Fiscal Year 2011 Appropriation Ordinance and contingent upon City Comptroller's certifying that funds are available.
