A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO
AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT
WITH URBAN CORPS OF SAN DIEGO FOR A BI-NATIONAL
RECYCLING AND RESTORATION INITIATIVE.

WHEREAS, the Urban Corps of San Diego is a legally constituted private nonprofit organization sponsoring a Bi-national Recycling and Restoration Initiative to establish recycling centers in Baja California; and

WHEREAS, the initiative is intended to reduce runoff into the Tijuana River Valley, increase recycling throughout Baja California, and create a recycling industry throughout the Baja region, which if successful, will have significant positive environmental effects on both sides of the border; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to further the goals of Contractor's Bi-national Recycling and Restoration Initiative by providing financial assistance to the project; NOW THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the City Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized and empowered to execute, for and on behalf of said City, an agreement in an amount not to exceed \$25,000.00 for the Urban Corps of San Diego's Bi-National Recycling and Restoration Initiative as set forth in the agreement on file in the office of the City Clerk as Document No. RR- 306051 .

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate and expend up to \$25,000.00 from the Infrastructure Improvement Fund, Council District 8, Fund 400688, for the above described project, contingent upon the Chief Financial

Officer first furnishing one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.
