A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL AUTHORIZING A GRANT APPLICATION AND TAKING RELATED ACTIONS IN CONNECTION WITH PARADISE HILLS COMMUNITY PARK PICNIC SHELTER.

WHEREAS, grant funding is available to the City from Roberti-Z'berg-Harris Per Capita Funds under the California Clean Water, Clean Air, Safe Neighborhood Parks, and Coastal Protection Act of 2002; and

WHEREAS, the City Council by Resolution No. R-305899 authorized the City to apply for and accept \$73,000 of such funds to construct the Paradise Hills Community Park Picnic Shelter; and

WHEREAS, the bid for the project was higher than anticipated, and additional grant funding may be available for completion of the improvements; NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

1. That the Mayor or his designee is authorized to apply for an additional \$40,000 in grant funding from Roberti-Z'berg-Harris Per Capita Funds for the Paradise Hills Community Park Picnic Shelter Project, CIP S-10023, and to take all necessary actions to secure funding.
2. That if grant funding is secured, the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to accept up to \$40,000 for the project, and to establish a special interest-bearing account for the grant funds if necessary.
3. That in accordance with the annual appropriation ordinance, the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to amend the Fiscal Year 2011 Capital Improvements Program budget by

increasing CIP S-10023, Paradise Hills Community Park Picnic Shelter, Roberti-Z'berg-Harris Per Capita Funds, by an amount up to \$40,000.



That upon receipt of a fully executed grant agreement, the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate and expend an additional amount not to exceed \$40,000 from CIP S-10023, Paradise Hills Community Picnic Park Shelter, Roberti-Z'berg-Harris Per Capita Funds, solely and exclusively to complete the project.
