A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS
REPRESENTATIVE TO ACCEPT AND EXPEND \$2,430,651
IN GRANT FUNDS RELATING TO OPERATION
STONEGARDEN

WHEREAS, Operation Stonegarden is a regional law enforcement approach that provides operational and equipment funds to address border-related crimes and increase law enforcement activities along the US-Mexico border areas. The Operation Stonegarden grant provides an opportunity for federal, state and local law enforcement to collaborate on intelligence based, proactive policing to combat illegal activities throughout San Diego County; and

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego entered into an agreement with the County of San Diego for joint law enforcement services along the land borders of the United States under the Department of Homeland Security Operation Stonegarden Grant Program (Operation Stonegarden); and

WHEREAS, the San Diego County Sheriff's Office (SDSO) was the recipient of grant funds from Operation Stonegarden and sub-contracted a portion of the grant funds to the San Diego Police Department (SDPD); and

WHEREAS, SDSO will reimburse SDPD for overtime, equipment, mileage, and flight costs associated with Operation Stonegarden; and

WHEREAS, the funds which will be reimbursed to SDPD are from SDSO via Cal EMA via the Department of Homeland Security "Operation Stonegarden"; and

WHEREAS, all expenses resulting from this action are grant funded, there is no requirement for continued expenditures or services once funding is depleted or terminated; and

WHEREAS, this agreement is not subject to the City's Equal Opportunity Contracting (San Diego Ordinance No. 18173, Section 22.2701 through 22.3517); and

WHEREAS, this agreement is subject to the City's Non-Discrimination in Contracting Ordinance (San Diego Municipal Code Sections 22.3501 through 22.3517); NOW,

THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor, or his representative is authorized to make application to the SDSO, and to take all necessary actions to secure funding for an amount up to \$2,430,651 pertaining to Operation Stonegarden;


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to establish a special interest-bearing fund for the grants, if required.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to accept up to \$2,430,651 or the actual amount of funding authorized by the SDSO.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate and expend up to \$2,430,651 or the actual amount of funding authorized by the SDSO, for the purpose of implementing the Operation Stonegarden, including any amendments, extensions, renewals, or subsequent funding for a period of five years, providing funding is made available by the SDSO.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief of Police is authorized to administer and operate this program.


