A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO OPPOSING PROPOSITION 27, A MEASURE TO REPEAL THE LAW CREATING THE CALIFORNIA CITIZENS REDISTRICTING COMMISSION, ON THE NOVEMBER 2010 GENERAL ELECTION BALLOT.

WHEREAS, Proposition 27, a state initiative measure that would repeal Proposition 11, which created the 14-member California Citizens Redistricting Commission, will be submitted to San Diego voters on the November 2010 ballot; and

WHEREAS, the measure, if adopted, would consolidate authority for the redistricting of state Assembly, Senate, and Board of Equalization district boundaries with elected representatives responsible for drawing Congressional districts; and

WHEREAS, the measure would reduce the budget and impose a limit on the amount the Legislature may spend for redistricting, and would allow voters the authority to reject district boundary maps approved by the Legislature; and

WHEREAS, the Intergovernmental Relations Department of the City of San Diego recommended that the City not take a position on the statewide ballot measure, stating that the City did not take a position on Proposition 11; and

WHEREAS, the City Council's Committee on Rules, Open Government and Intergovernmental Relations considered the measure at its meeting of September 22, 2010 and voted to recommend that the City Council oppose Proposition 27; and

WHEREAS, no public funds shall be used in the campaign for or against the measure; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that the San Diego City Council opposes Proposition 27, a state initiative measure that would repeal the law creating the California Citizens Redistricting Commission, which will be submitted to San Diego voters on the November 2010 ballot.
