A RESOLUTION DECLARING A HOMELESS SHELTER
CRISIS IN THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO IN ACCORDANCE
WITH CALIFORNIA GOVERNMENT CODE
SECTION 8698.2 (a)(1).

WHEREAS, the City of San Diego (City) has received nearly three-quarters of an inch of rain at least one month earlier than usual weather patterns provide; and

WHEREAS, the economy in San Diego is in severe distress--unemployment has reached nearly unprecedented levels; banks are not making as many loans to purchase houses as they were earlier in this crisis; and new government assistance programs have not supplied the relief hoped for; and

WHEREAS, it has been reported that the population of homeless people in the San Diego region has increased recently by almost 1,000 people; and


WHEREAS, according to the Fiscal Year 2010 homeless profile compiled by the Regional Task Force profile, there were an estimated 4,526 homeless persons living in the City last winter; and

WHEREAS, of these persons, 2,049 were living on the streets as the City has insufficient beds to shelter these persons; and

WHEREAS, the weather conditions during the cold weather season result in a threat to the health and safety of those persons; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, that a homeless shelter crisis exists in the City of San Diego, in accordance with California Government Code section 8698.2 (a)(1).
