A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING ADVERTISEMENT AND AWARD OF THE CANYON VIEW UPLAND MITIGATION PROJECT AND RELATED ACTIONS.

WHEREAS, the Canyon View Upland Mitigation Project [Project] involves the restoration of approximately 0.9 acre of native grassland and 6.79 acres of coastal sage scrub habitat located on City of San Diego owned parcels within Los Penasquitos Canyon and mitigation within the Los Penasquitos Canyon Preserve; and

WHEREAS, the Project will consist of site preparation, removal of exotic plant species, installation of erosion control measures, installation of a temporary recycled water irrigation system, revegetation, and the implementation of a long-term maintenance and monitoring period;

NOW THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego as follows:

1. That after advertising for bids in accordance with law, the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to award and execute a construction contract for the Project with the lowest responsible and reliable bidder.

2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate and expend an amount not to exceed \$1,086,077 from the operating budget of Sewer Fund 70000 for the purpose of funding construction of the Project, contingent upon the City Comptroller furnishing one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.

3. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized, upon advice from the administering department, to transfer excess budgeted funds, if any, to the appropriate reserves.
