DATE OF FINAL PASSAGE NOV 16 2010

A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, AND EXPEND \$200,000 IN GRANT FUNDS FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, OFFICE OF COMMUNITY ORIENTED POLICING SERVICES TECHNOLOGY PROGRAM, FISCAL YEAR 2010.

WHEREAS, this action is a three-year grant from the United states Department of Justice, Office of Community Oriented Policing Services; and

WHEREAS, for the current grant period (December 16, 2009, through December 15, 2012), the grant will provide \$200,000; and

WHEREAS, the crime laboratory of the San Diego Police Department consists of sixty-three employees; and

WHEREAS, if approved, this grant would be used to fund equipment and supplies that will enhance the efficiency of the crime laboratory; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that the Mayor or his designee, is authorized to apply for, accept, and expend grant funding up to \$200,000 from the United States Department of Justice Office of Community Oriented Policing Services (COPS), as part of the Fiscal Year 2010 Technology Grant Program.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to establish a special interest-bearing fund for the grants, if required.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate and expend up to \$200,000 or the actual amount of funding authorized by the COPS Office of the United States Department of Justice (DOJ), to include the purchase of supplies and equipment.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the San Diego Chief of Police is authorized to administer and operate this program for a period of up to three years, provided that funding for this purpose is made available by the DOJ.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to accept up to \$200,000 or the actual amount of funding authorized by the COPS Office of the DOJ.
