A RESOLUTION SUMMARILY VACATING A WATER ACCESS EASEMENT – PROJECT NUMBER 68311.

WHEREAS, California Streets and Highways Code section 8330 et seq. San Diego Municipal Code section 125.1001 et seq. provide a procedure for the summary vacation of public easements by City Council resolution; and

WHEREAS, it is proposed that an existing water access easement, Easement Abandonment No. 206767 be vacated; and

WHEREAS, (1) The easement has not been used for the purpose for which it was dedicated or acquired for 5 consecutive years immediately proceeding the proposed abandonment; and (2) The easement has been superseded by relocation and there are no other public facilities located within the easement; and

WHEREAS, the easement does not contain public utility facilities; or does not contain active public utility facilities that would be affected by the abandonment; and

WHEREAS, under Charter Section 280(a)(2), this resolution is not subject to veto by the Mayor because this matter requires the City Council to act as a quasi-judicial body, a public hearing was required by law implicating due process rights of individuals affected by the decision, and the Council was required by law to consider evidence at the hearing and to make legal findings based on the evidence presented; and

WHEREAS, the matter was set for public hearing on October 19, 2010, testimony having been heard, evidence having been submitted, and the City Council having fully considered the matter and being fully advised concerning the same; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that with respect to the water access easement, the Council finds that:

(a) There is no present or prospective use for the easement, either for the facility or purpose for which it was originally acquired, or for any other public use of a like nature that can be anticipated.

The water access easement was originally established as a part of Lot 128 of Map No. 14015 to grant vehicle access to the City of San Diego to the Santa Fe Irrigation District flume right-of-way. The Santa Fe Irrigation District and the San Dieguito Water District jointly released all interests to the flume and all rights of access to the flume across Lot 128 via a quitclaim deed recorded on December 21, 2004 (Document No. 2004-1200431). A new 36-inch waterline was installed within the State Route 6 Del Dios Highway right-of-way eliminating the need to access the water flume. Therefore, the water access easement is no longer in use and is no longer required by the City of San Diego.

(b) The public will benefit from the abandonment through improved utilization of the land made available by the abandonment.

The public would benefit from the abandonment by releasing the City of San Diego from any liability inherent in the ownership interest of the easement and the improved utilization of the land through potential future development.

(c) The abandonment is consistent with any applicable land use plan.

The property on which the easement is located is outside the San Diego city limits and therefore there is no applicable land use plan for this site within the jurisdiction of the City.

(d) The public facility or purpose for which the easement was originally acquired will

not be detrimentally affected by this abandonment or the purpose for which the easement was

acquired no longer exists.

The purpose for which the easement was originally acquired was to establish access

rights for City of San Diego vehicles across Lot 128 to the Santa Fe water flume. A new 36-inch

waterline was installed within the adjacent State Route 6 (S6) Del Dios Highway right-of-way

eliminating the need to access the water flume. Therefore, the purpose for which the easement

was acquired no longer exists.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the water access easement located within the

County of San Diego and owned by the City of San Diego, as more particularly described in the

legal description marked as Exhibit "A," and shown on Drawing No. 20356-3-B, marked as

Exhibit "B," which are by this reference incorporated herein and made a part hereof, is ordered

vacated.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Development Services Department shall record

a certified copy of this resolution with attached exhibits, attested by the City Clerk under seal, in

the office of the County Recorder.
