A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO
TO APPLY FOR, ACCEPT, APPROPRIATE, AND EXPEND GRANT
FUNDING OF \$250,000 FROM THE CALIFORNIA COASTAL
CONSERVANCY FOR A SEDIMENT MANAGEMENT PROJECT IN
THE TIJUANA RIVER VALLEY

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego as follows:

1. That the Mayor or his designee is authorized, for and on behalf of the City, to apply for and take all necessary actions to submit applications and associated project summaries to the California State Coastal Conservancy to secure funding for an amount of \$250,000 in grant funds for Sediment Management and Nelson-Sloan Quarry Reclamation Project within the Tijuana River Valley.
2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to accept up to \$250,000 if grant funding is secured.
3. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to establish a special interest-bearing account for the grant.

4. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate and expend up to \$250,000 of grant funds from the California Coast Conservancy contingent upon receipt of a fully executed grant agreement.
