A RESOLUTION OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
SAN DIEGO ALLOCATING DISCRETIONARY FUNDING TO
THE PACIFIC SAFETY COUNCIL.

WHEREAS, funds were allocated in the Fiscal Year 2011 Annual Budget for Special Promotional Programs intended to advance the City's economy by promoting the City of San Diego as a visitor destination in the national and international marketplace; and

WHEREAS, the Pacific Safety Council is dedicated to making our communities safer places to live, learn, work, and play, by providing quality education, information, programs and events; and

WHEREAS, the Pacific Safety Council provides programs to increase Child Safety Seat Awareness around San Diego County through education which leads to an increase in the number of Child Safety seats correctly installed; and

WHEREAS, it is the determination of the City Council that the Pacific Safety Council Program fits within the parameters of the Special Promotional Programs set forth in the Fiscal Year 2011 Annual Budget; and

WHEREAS, the City desires to enter into an agreement with the Pacific Safety Council to provide and the Pacific Safety Council has agreed to provide the Child Safety Seat Awareness Program (Program) at the Pacific Safety Council's Child Safety Fair; and

WHEREAS, the Pacific Safety Council has proposed to expend \$8,000 for the Child Safety Fair and has requested the City of San Diego to provide \$2,000 in funding for

the Program from the Special Promotional Programs, Mayor and City Council Discretionary Funding line item set forth in the Special Promotional Programs portion of the Annual Budget;
NOW, THEREFORE,


BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that pursuant to Council Policy 100-03 all general requirements regarding application and funding recommendations are hereby waived.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Mayor, or his designee, is authorized to negotiate and execute for and on behalf of the City, an agreement in an amount not to exceed \$2,000 for the Pacific Safety Council's Child Safety Fair.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to appropriate and expend up to \$2,000 from the Special Promotional Programs, Mayor and City Council Discretionary Funding, for the above described project, contingent upon the Chief Financial Officer first furnishing one or more certificates certifying that the funds necessary for expenditure are, or will be, on deposit with the City Treasurer.
