WHEREAS, section 265(b)(12) of the City Charter provides that the Mayor has the sole authority to appoint City representatives to boards, commissions, committees and governmental agencies, unless controlling law vests the power of appointment with the City Council or a City Official other than the Mayor; and


WHEREAS, a review of the various boards, commissions, committees and governmental agencies to which the City appoints representatives confirms that some appointments of City representatives (members of the City Council or the Mayor) may be accomplished by the Mayor alone, or by the Mayor and City Council acting jointly; and

WHEREAS, the Council President and the Mayor have agreed to jointly appoint the elected officials to serve as the City's representatives to these boards, commissions, committees and governmental agencies; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, that Councilmember Marti Emerald is hereby appointed jointly by the Mayor and City Council to serve as representative, alternate, or liaison to the organizations listed below, effective through December 2011, and until a successor is duly appointed and confirmed.
