AN ORDINANCE OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN DIEGO AUTHORIZING A SECOND AMENDMENT TO THE AGREEMENT WITH WLC ARCHITECTS, INC. FOR THE EAST MISSION VALLEY FIRE STATION NO. 45

WHEREAS, on April 16, 2002, the City entered into an agreement with WLC Architects, Inc. to provide design services for a new facility, the East Mission Valley Fire Station No. 45 (which was formerly designated Fire Station No. 2) (Project), for an amount of \$371,540, a copy of which agreement is on file at RR-296360; and

WHEREAS, on February 1, 2005, the parties entered into a first amendment to the agreement for additional architectural design services and preparation of construction documents, for the amount of \$302,710, a copy of which amendment is on file at RR-300104; and

WHEREAS, the plans for the Project were developed to approximately ninety percent completion, but then due to lack of funding the Project was placed on hold; and

WHEREAS, funding is now available to complete the design of the Project and it is necessary to update the plans to meet the current building code and comply with the new LEED requirements; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend the agreement to provide for updating of the plans, compliance with new LEED requirements, completion of the plans and specifications, and provision of construction support and as-built drawings; and

WHEREAS, under Charter Section 99, no contract, agreement or obligation extending for a period of more than five years may be authorized except by ordinance approved by a two-thirds majority vote of the City Council; NOW, THEREFORE,

BE IT ORDAINED, by the Council of the City of San Diego, as follows:

Section 2. That the Chief Financial Officer is authorized to expend an amount not to exceed \$175,750 from CIP S-00688, East Mission Valley Fire Station No. 45, of which \$100,000 is from Fund 400624, Deferred Maintenance 2009A-Project, and \$75,750 is from Fund 400135, Mission Valley DIF, for the purpose of providing funds for Project.

Section 3. That the Chief Financial Officer, upon advice from the administering department, is authorized to transfer excess funds, if any, to the appropriate reserves.

Section 4. That a full reading of this ordinance is dispensed with prior to its passage, a written or printed copy having been made available to the City Council and the public prior to the day of its passage.

Section 5. That this ordinance shall take effect and be in force on the thirtieth day from and after its final passage.
